SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- The Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman's Car Trial on Sunday 6th April 2025 at Stoneacre Farm, Otham Kent. The event will be open to all fully elected members of the organizing club, Weald MC, Farnborough & District MC, Anglia Motor Sports Club, Falcon MC, MGCC SE Centre and all registered contenders of the 2025 ASEMC Trials Championships. [PEPERMIT/CH2025/T007].
 - Members of up to the first 10 other Motorsport UK recognised clubs received may also enter and such entry will be deemed acceptance of an invitation on behalf of that club.
 - The meeting will be held under the Motorsport UK National Competition Rules (NCR) incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the Clubs may issue for the Event.
- 2. The Motorsport UK Clubman Permit No 202742
- 3. The event will take place at Stoneacre Farm, Otham, Kent ME15 8RS and will take place entirely on Private Land. Weather and other circumstances permitting there will be 6 hills, with two runs at each in the morning and two in the afternoon. The Event will start at 10.00 hours. Any competitor who has not checked in with the Secretary of the Meeting by 10.00 hours may be excluded. Competitors may elect to run without a passenger but must declare this on their entry form and continue without throughout the competition. If a competitor elects to carry a passenger, the passenger(s) must hold a R S Clubman's Licence and have completed the pre-event signing on declaration on the Club website.
- 4. All competitors and passengers must be in possession of a valid Club Membership Card and a R S Clubman Competition Licence as a minimum. NCR 17.2.1.4
- 5. This is an All Day event and no food will be available on site. Food and/or Petrol is available at the M20 Jnt 8 Services, Yeoman Tesco Local on the A20, Morrison's next to the Kent Police HQ on the A274 and Lidl on the A274, all within 2 miles of the venue, should you require either.
- All cars will comply with the 2025 Motorsport UK Vehicle and Tyre Regulations for Car Trials, section NCR17.4.2-10

The following classes will apply:

Class A Ch17.4.1

Standard Two Wheel Drive Production Cars first registered on or after 1st January 1998, Taxed and MOTed for road use.

Cars in this class can however be trailered to the venue.

Full interior trim to be retained, carrying no ballast and having no modifications except as follows:It is permitted to fit a sump guard weighing no more than 10kg. Wheels and tyres may be altered in accordance with Motorsport UK NCT 17.4.8.2, 8.3 and 8.4b to d.

Minimum tyre pressure – up to 1200cc, 12psi, 1201 to 1400cc, 14psi and over 1400cc 16psi.

Class B Ch17.4.14

Front Wheel Drive Series Production Cars not eligible for Class A.

Permitted modifications in accordance with NCR 174.2.1 – 10.5

Minimum tyre pressures – up to 1200cc, 12psi, 1201 to 1400cc, 14psi and over 1400cc. 16psi.

Class C Ch17.4.1.5

Rear Wheel Drive Series Production cars not eligible for Class A

Permitted modifications in accordance with NCR 17.4.2.1 – 10.5

Minimum tyre pressures – Front engine, 14psi, Mid/rear engine 20psi.

Class D Ch17.4.1.6

Series Production Cars not eligible for any other class, Kit Cars and Specials.

Minimum tyre pressures.

FE Sports Cars up to 1800: 16psi FE Sports Car over 1800cc: 22psi FE Saloon Cars up to 1800cc: 14psi FE Saloon Cars over 1800cc: 20psi RE Cars up to 1000cc: 22psi RE Cars over 1000cc: 26psi

Note:

Cars in classes A & B with an overall length of 4.21m (166inches) and over may reduce tyre pressures below the stated class pressures by not more that 4psi subject to an absolute minimum of 12psi.

- 7. Classification of any vehicle will be entirely at the discretion of the organisers. Scrutineering safety checks will be undertaken.
- 8. Awards will be presented as follows:

First Overall (least total of penalties).

First in each Class.

Second in each Class, subject to five entries

Third in each class, subject to eight entries

Best performance by a MGCC member.

Classes with less than two entries may be amalgamated at the organizer's discretion. (No Competitor may win more than one award)

- 9. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes at 22.00 on **Monday 31**st **March 2025.**
 - Entries and signing on will be on line via the Club Website at www.mmkmc.co.uk and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. The entry fee is £35.00. Payment may be made by BACS, to MMKMC Bank Account sort code 60-60-08 Account No 00045349, PayPal or by post to the Secretary of the meeting. Please state your name and event name if paying by BACS Entry fees may be refunded at the organizer's discretion.

Entries will be accepted from drivers aged 14,15 or 16 or over who do not hold a full RTA Licence. These drivers must be accompanied by a passenger who holds a full RTA License and is experienced as a driver of Car Trials.

11. The maximum number of entries for this event is 40 the minimum is 15. There is no maximum or minimum class entry. Should the minimum entry figure not be reached, the organizer's reserve the right to cancel the meeting. A maximum of two (at the organizer's discretion) drivers per car will be accepted, each being treated as a separate entry.

The signing on and pre-event declaration required by MOTORSPORT UK will be done at the time of entry via the Club website. A separate pre-event declaration form must be completed prior to the event by passengers in the same way. Final instructions will be made available to entrants before the start of the competition.

- 12. We bring your attention to NCR 17.2.7.2 7.7 and remind you that no front passenger may be under the age of 12 years in saloon or hardtop vehicles or under the age of 14 in open or convertible vehicles. Passenger(s) comprising the crew at the start must not be altered during the competition.
- 13. Numbers will be allocated by the organisers. NCR 17.2.3.2. Starting order will be in accordance with NCR 17.2.3.3.
- 14. Penalties will be as NCR 17.2.4. and 5.
- 15. No score cards will be given to competitors as scoring and results will be by the TrialsAppLive App. Results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event and will be available on the Club Website www.mmkmc.co.uk.thereafter. Protests must be made in accordance with NCR 2.9.
- 16. Identification numbers will be allocated by the organisers but the supply of this is the responsibility of the entrants and must be fixed in a prominent forward-facing position.
- 17. All marshals are appointed Judges to adjudicate on items listed under NCR 17.2.5
- 18. As the event takes place on private property, apart from Class A, cars need not be currently registered, taxed and MOT'ed, but they must be properly silenced.
- 19. In accordance with latest General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) the information you give us will be used only for the purpose of running MMKMC events and its activities. You will only receive communications from us that are relevant to the events you enter. Photographs may be taken at this event (and others in the programme) and shared, including on social media. Please advise the organiser if you do not wish to have your photograph taken.
