



## Mike Jordan Classic Tour 2021 Regulations

We are pleased to be able to announce the return of our classic tour in the name of the late Mike Jordan. We expect to be able to make a donation to Myeloma UK in his name from any surplus funds arising on the event.

### 1. ORGANISATION

Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd will organise the **Mike Jordan Classic Tour**, a Touring Assembly, on Saturday 3 July 2021. The event will be held under a Certificate of Exemption number 121998 issued by the Motorsport UK, these Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. The event is open to four-wheeled road cars first registered before 1 January 1998. Interesting later cars may be accepted at the organiser's discretion. Please contact the entry secretary if you wish to discuss eligibility.
- 2.2. All cars must hold a V5C Registration Document, current road fund licence, and have a valid MOT certificate. Cars must not carry any competition numbers.
- 2.3. Any person may enter the event.
- 2.4 All drivers must be in possession of a valid driving licence for the car being driven. A Competition Licence is not required.
- 2.4. **At the time of production of these regulations if all crew members are not living in the same household, or part of the same support bubble, face masks must be worn whilst in the car.**

### 3. ENTRIES

- 3.1. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close finally at 10 pm on Monday 28 June 2021 . All entries must be made online at [www.mmkmc.co.uk](http://www.mmkmc.co.uk) to be followed by payment of the entry fee of **£80** if two people will be travelling in the car. Please add **£20** for each additional person.
- 3.2. Final Instructions (including an Entry List and directions to the Start) will be emailed to participants during the week prior to the event.
- 3.3. The entry fee includes one Roadbook, one rigid Rally Plate, a bacon roll with tea or coffee at the start and a two course meal at the finish.

- 3.5. The maximum number of cars on the event is forty. The minimum is twenty. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organiser's reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt as long as payment has been received.
- 3.6. The running order will be decided by the organisers. If an entrant would like to run close to a friend/colleague, please advise the entry secretary by email [chairman@mmkmc.co.uk](mailto:chairman@mmkmc.co.uk)

- 3.7. Entries withdrawn before 10 pm on 28 June 2021 will have the entry fee returned in full.  
Entries withdrawn after this date may not be the subject of a refund of the entry fee.

#### **4. COVID-19 REGULATIONS**

Please bring your own hand cleaning gel/wipes as needed and comply with social distancing measures at all times.

Please also note that you must agree to the following declaration as part of your entry: Please read and complete the declaration which will be available on the Club Website at [www.mmkmc.co.uk](http://www.mmkmc.co.uk) a few days before the event. (a link will be emailed to all drivers and passengers).

*"I am not currently experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 and have not been in contact with anyone showing symptoms within the last 14 days, except as a healthcare professional. If after submitting this form I do come into contact (except as a healthcare professional) with someone with COVID-19 or if I start to exhibit any of the signs indicating that I may be infected I will immediately withdraw from the Event, notify Motorsport UK and ensure that my close contacts also do not attend. Should I become ill at or start to exhibit COVID-19 symptoms at the Event I shall withdraw safely and notify the Secretary of the Meeting by telephone / SMS accordingly including identification of those others who I have come into contact with at the Event."*

#### **5. ROUTE**

- 5.1. The event will start and finish at the Pepperbox Inn, Windmill Hill, Harrietsham, Maidstone ME17 1LP.
- 5.2. The route will cover approximately 100 miles
- 5.3. The route will be given in an easy to follow Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event.
- 5.4. The first car will leave the start at 10 am.
- 5.5. Along the route, there may be check points to observe the entrant's adherence to the defined route. These check points will be open for specified periods, giving adequate time to visit them while they are open.

#### **6. START**

A pack with each entrant's Rally Plate and Road Book will be produced at least 72 hours before the start in accordance with the current guidelines. It is recommended that cars and entrants arrive at the start at least 60 minutes before the start time to collect this and enjoy the refreshments available.

#### **7. IDENTIFICATION**

Competitors will be identified by a Rally Plate, which will be supplied by the organisers. This must be displayed in a prominent forward facing position on the vehicle.

#### **8. INSURANCE**

All entrants must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event, and they will be required to sign a declaration to this effect as part of the pre event electronic signing on process. The event has no competitive element.
