## Championship Regulations 2021

### General Regulations

1. For points to be accumulated for any event you must be a paid-up member of Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club (MMKMC). Results will only count from the time of receipt of your subscription renewal.
2. For points to be accumulated you must be entered into that event as an MMKMC member. Results will not count if entered as belonging to another club, even if you have additional membership with MMKMC.
3. To encourage members to take an active part in organising events without sacrificing their championship position, points will be awarded to event organisers as if a class win had occurred in the largest class. Only one set of organiser points may be claimed per season per championship in which you compete. If you do not compete in a championship you cannot claim points towards it, however you will receive points for either the Marshal or Event Organiser championships accordingly. Competitors who are required to marshal at an Autosolo cannot claim marshal points as it is a requirement of the event regulations to do so.
4. It is the responsibility of the individual member to ensure that copies of the results are sent to the Championship Secretary by email at the address below **within one month of the event results being declared final (except results for events run in December when they should be received by 10<sup>th</sup> January latest).**

5. Championship tables will be issued regularly in the Kent Driver and on the MMKMC website ([www.mmkmc.co.uk](http://www.mmkmc.co.uk)). Any queries regarding scores must be raised within 4 weeks of publication.
6. The Board of Directors will act as an adjudication panel in the event of disputes or queries that are unable to be resolved by the Championship secretary.
7. Motorsport UK authorised events include any Motorsport UK authorised competitive event in the UK or authorised by the appropriate motor sport governing body if overseas.
8. **MMKMC Event Organisers** – Please email a list of the signed-on Officials & Marshals and results to the Championship Secretary after every event.

## Scoring

All points are based on Class Results. Points will be awarded based on finishing position within the class. These points apply to all championships except the Marshal Award.

Where classes are amalgamated on an event, they will be treated as one for championship points.

Where an event has no Class structure then if 10 or more entrants, scoring will be as "Largest Class". If there are nine or less entrants, then points will commence from 10 down.

In the event of a tie in any Championship at the end of the year, the "count back" system will be implemented. The winner will be the competitor with the highest number of first in class wins. If this still leaves a tie, then the number of second in class wins (and any subsequent positions if required) will be taken into account until a clear winner is identified.

## Club Driver Award

This award is made to the MMKMC member aged 18 and over on 1<sup>st</sup> of January of the current championship year who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by driving in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive motor sport event. Points must be obtained from more than one driving discipline. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations.

## **Young Club Competitor Award**

This award is made to the MMKMC member aged under 18 on 1<sup>st</sup> of January of the current Championship year, who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by competing in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive event. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations.

## **Senior Club Driver Award**

This award is made to the MMKMC member aged 70 and over on 1<sup>st</sup> of January of the current Championship year who accumulates most points throughout the course of the year from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by driving in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive event. Points must be obtained from more than one discipline. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations.

## **Most Improved Competitor Award**

This award is made to the MMKMC member who has shown significant improvement throughout the course of the year, whether through driving, navigating, marshalling or organising. The recipient is chosen by the Board of Directors.

## **Road Rally Driver & Navigator Championships**

These awards are made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by competing in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive rally (Targa and Special Stage Rallies excluded) as a driver or navigator. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations. Navigator's points cannot be counted towards any Club Driver award.

## **Special Stage Rally Driver & Co-Driver Championships**

These awards are made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by competing in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive Special Stage rally either in the UK or abroad as a driver or co-driver. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations. Co-driver points cannot be counted towards any Club Driver award.

## **Targa Rally Driver & Co-Driver Championships**

These awards are made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by competing in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive Targa Rally. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations. Co-driver points cannot be counted towards any Club Driver award.

## **Race/Sprint/Hillclimb Championship**

This award is made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by driving in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive Race, Sprint or Hill Climb. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations.

## **Car Trials Championship**

This award is made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by driving in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive Car Trial. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations.

## **Grass Autotest Championship (MMKMC events ONLY)**

This award will be made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by driving in any MMKMC organised competitive Grass Autotest. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations.

## **Tarmac Autotest & AutoSolo Championship**

This award is made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by driving in any Motorsport UK authorised competitive Tarmac Autotest or AutoSolo. Points will be awarded for all events for which Final Results are submitted in accordance with section 4 of the General Regulations.

## **Marshal Award**

This award is made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by marshalling on any **MMKMC organised** event. Points will be awarded for all MMKMC events at which the member has signed on as a marshal. Anyone signed on as a competitor cannot subsequently sign on as a marshal at the same event. A marshal is deemed to be a person signed on as such who is NOT a named official. This award is a “standalone” award and does not count towards any other championships.

*Scoring is a flat rate of 10 points per event.*

## **Event Official Award**

This award is made to the MMKMC member who accumulates the most points throughout the course of the year, from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December by acting as a “named official” on any **MMKMC organised** event. Points will be awarded for all MMKMC events at which the member has signed on as an official. Anyone signed on as a competitor cannot subsequently sign on as an event official at the same event. A “named official” includes but is not limited to any of the following: Clerk of the Course, Secretary of the Meeting, Steward, Scrutineer, Chief Marshal, Chief Timekeeper and Results Team. This award is a “standalone” award and does not count towards any other championships.

*Scoring is at a flat rate of 10 points per event.*
